Safeguards are in place

Federal law prevents unethical stem cell experiments from being performed on human subjects. Furthermore, there are Embryonic Stem Cell Research Oversight Committees, set up under guidance from the National Academy of Sciences, that oversee all aspects of embryonic stem cell research.

And the argument that private companies could do whatever research they want is not true because the Food and Drug Administration regulates research at private companies on the development and testing of any medical product. These regulations ensure that such research is performed ethically.

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
