LOCAL: Ex-Congressman Schwarz coming to county to talk about stem cells

Michigan Citizens for Stem Cell Research and Cures and the Livingston County Democratic Party are hosting an event on stem cell research featuring former Republican Congressman Joe Schwarz of Battle Creek.

Schwarz, a physician, will be joined by Marcia Baum, executive director of the stem cell group.

Schwarz served one term in Congress before being defeated in the 2006 Republican primary by Tim Walberg.

Michigan has one of the most restrictive laws against stem cell research in the country, according to the press release announcing the event.
