This week two teams of scientists reported they had developed lines of human stem cells almost identical to embryonic ones. Because the technique does not destroy embryos, it avoids the main ethical objection to embryonic stem cell research. Perhaps this is the breakthrough that Michigan needs to get past the state's science versus ethics stalemate and pass legislation to allow critically needed research and development work be done in the state.
